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Contribution to the organisation and training industry

Palan with his rich experience and background, holding prominent positions in the human resources, marketing and teaching and leadership positions is the pioneer of the renowned Trainers-Meet-Trainers (TMT) and Asia HRD Congress.

Trainers-Meet-Trainers (TMT) was born as a half-day session on a complimentary basis in 1977 run by a single trainer which attracted more than 40 participants. Subsequent TMT events continued with a single trainer running the sessions until 1990.

Due to popular demands, a 2-Day conference was held in 1994 which attracted almost 600 participants.

In 1997 the TMT Conference attracted more than 1,000 participants from Malaysia and abroad.

The TMT Conference was last held in 2001 as Trainers-Meet-Trainers Asia before it expanded in scope and evolved into the Asia HRD Congress in 2002 when the TMT entered its 25th year, Silver Jubilee Year. Workshops gained a new look. Post conference workshops were introduced.

It was with Palan's vision and realisation of the need to provide a platform for all HR professionals alike to share and learn that the above events were born. What started on a small scale has now boomed into being recognised and appreciated HR events especially among the Asian audience.

Aside from that, Palan has trained thousands in the Certificate in Training Practice (CTP) and Accredited Training Professional (ATP) earning him an established reputation as a Master Trainer among the HR community.
